Remember: CLEAR BAGS ONLY!



Garbage

- Raw meat
 - Bubble gum & packaging 
 - Glass – windows, cups & ceramics
 - Soiled plastic wrap & aluminum foil
 - Styrofoam peanuts & small pieces
 - Bandages & gauze (no needles) 
 - Hygiene products 
 - Bathroom waste & cosmetics
 - Diapers & wipes 
 - Dryer & cleaner sheets
 - Vacuum bags & contents 
 - Obsolete cassettes & VHS'

Fees

Additional Bags of Garbage - \$2/bag for each bag over limit – both sites

Kallio Site Only:

Large Appliances - \$5 – per appliance (hot water tanks, stoves, etc. NOTE Fridges, freezers, etc. must be drained & tagged

Furniture - \$5 – per item (bed, dresser, mattress, etc.)

**Burnable Brush or Clean Bldg. Material - \$25/pick up load
\$75/single axle load
\$125 /tandem axle load**

**Asphalt Shingles - \$150 / pick up truck load
\$250 / single axle load
\$300 / tandem axle load**

Electronic Waste – free to recycle in OES Bin @ Kallio site

CONTAINERS

- SODA CANS**
TIP: Slightly dented cans should not be crushed.
- PLASTIC BOTTLES**
TIP: Crush plastic bottles and keep caps ON.
- PLASTIC TUBS & JUGS**
TIP: Ensure containers are rinsed and empty and keep caps OFF.
- TIN CANS**
TIP: There's no need to remove the paper labels.
- ALUMINUM TRAYS**
TIP: Only recycle trays and lids if they are clean.
- GLASS BOTTLES & JARS**
TIP: There's no need to remove the paper labels.
- SMALL PLANT POTS**
TIP: Stack pots and ensure they do not contain soil.
- STYROFOAM MEAT TRAYS**
TIP: Packing styrofoam and foam pellets are not recyclable.
- GROCERY BAGS & PLASTIC FILM**
TIP: Contain all plastic film inside a grocery bag to prevent it from blowing away.
- PAINT CANS**
TIP: Ensure cans are empty, dry and the lid is removed.
- AEROSOLS**
TIP: Empty health, beauty and food aerosols are accepted.

PAPER PRODUCTS

- NEWSPAPER**
TIP: Remove water plastic bags.
- MAGAZINES & CATALOGS**
TIP: Place these heavier items on top to weigh down the loose paper products.
- HARD & SOFT COVER BOOKS**
TIP: There is no need to remove the covers.
- PAPER & JUNK MAIL**
TIP: Include envelopes, letters, etc. Stretched paper is also accepted.
- CARTONS & TETRAPAKS**
TIP: Keep lids ON.
- BOXBOARD**
TIP: Flatten or Blue Box to create more room for other recyclables.
- SPIRAL WOUND TUBES**
TIP: This is a mixed material, but it is accepted in the Paper Products bin.
- CORRUGATED CARDBOARD**
TIP: Bundle and tie cardboard and place inside blue boxes. Bundles should be no larger than 100cm x 100cm x 20cm.
